Square ID: BN

Flower color dark purple

Number of petals 5 but they don't all look the same

Draw a flower, a leaf, a stem

Other notes: Leaves look like spokes of a wheel and meet the stem at the middle. Kind of fuzzy and silvery.

Guess at ID: lupine
